



Park Construction Projects

Pronghorn Park in the Weatherstone Neighborhood

Similar to other Highlands Ranch neighborhood parks, this park features a playground, shelter, restroom and off-street parking. A multi-use sports field (for open play and programmed youth sports) will be built in the future.

This park is located on Weatherstone Way, south of Wildcat Reserve Parkway. Phase I was completed in September 2006. The multi-use sports field will be built as part of the elementary school site improvements.

With a budget of \$719,380, this neighborhood park was designed to serve 4,000 to 5,000 residents living within one half mile of the site.

Park N-9 Adjacent to the Recreation Center at Southridge

Like other Highlands Ranch neighborhood parks, this park will feature a multi-use sports field (for open and programmed youth sports), a playground, shelter, restroom and a parking lot.

This park will be located at McArthur Ranch Road and Laurelglen Lane, adjacent to the Recreation Center at Southridge. Construction should begin in late fall 2007, with completion anticipated in spring 2008.

With a budget of \$707,380, this neighborhood park is designed to serve 4,000 to 5,000 residents living within one half mile of the site.
