3385 Asterbrook Circle, west of Fairview Parkway and Summit View Parkway

Hound Hill Dog Park at Highland Heritage Park, Tuesday, October 27, 4:30 – 5:30 pm
South of the Highlands Ranch Post Office near the intersection of University and Quebec

Guests will be encouraged to participate in an online survey to provide input on amenities and upgrades they would like to see at dog parks in Highlands Ranch. The Metro District is considering making improvements at the dog parks to provide a better experience for both dogs and their owners.
